Over 250 organizations have taken [The Pledge for Full LGBT Equality](#) calling on Congress to pass a comprehensive non-discrimination law to protect the human rights of LGBT Americans on an equal basis with all other minorities under the 1964 Civil Rights Act and related laws.

In 2015, [The Equality Act](#) was filed to add “sexual orientation” and “gender identity” to all the relevant civil rights laws. It also adds “sex” to Title VI.
